## **Expression of Interest**

### **The United Nations World Food Programme seeks Overland Transport, Clearing and Forwarding Service Providers for services from Turkiye**

---

The United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) in Türkiye is reviewing and updating its shortlist of transporters and clearing & forwarding agents for overland transportation services. These services cover food and non-food relief consignments from various locations in Türkiye—primarily Mersin and its seaports—to neighboring countries, including but not limited to Syria, Lebanon, Iran, Iraq, Afghanistan and Palestine. Commodities to be cleared and transported, will consist mainly of food commodities such as cereals, pulses, pasta, edible oils, canned beans, and sugar (arriving in both containerized and bulk/break-bulk consignments) and non-food items.

Transport companies interested in providing these services and registered to carry out customs clearance services and deliveries of transit goods, are requested to complete a Transport Questionnaire (see below for details). Only those transportation companies with proven and documented records of successful operations need to reply to this Expression of Interest. Please note that WFP is interested especially in transport companies with access to a large pool of trucks, preferably having their own fleet.
