

# **CHECK YOUR VEHICLE'S CO<sub>2</sub> EMISSION CLASS**



## **Starting from 1 March 2024**

the method of calculating tolls based on the level of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions is changing. If you own a vehicle registered after 1 July 2019, check its CO<sub>2</sub> emission class in the registration documents and at:

## FROM 1 MARCH 2024 THE METHOD OF CALCULATING TOLLS IS CHANGING TO ACCOUNT FOR CO<sub>2</sub> EMISSIONS LEVELS.

- For vehicles first registered before 1 July 2019, or for vehicles in category M2 and M3 (buses), there is no need for further action. These vehicles will automatically be included in CO<sub>2</sub> emission class 1, with the exception of vehicles powered purely by electricity or hydrogen which will be assigned to CO<sub>2</sub> emission class 5.
- If your vehicle was first registered after 1 July 2019, you can use the CO<sub>2</sub> emission class finder ([www.myto.cz/en/kalkulace-co2](http://www.myto.cz/en/kalkulace-co2)) to find out if your vehicle is eligible to be included in a higher CO<sub>2</sub> emission class with lower fees.

## WHAT DO I NEED TO DETERMINE A VEHICLE CO<sub>2</sub> EMISSION CLASS?



### 3 Details

- Date on which the vehicle was first registered - you can find this in the vehicle registration certificate (technical certificate)
- Vehicle subgroup - can be found in the CIF document or in the COC document (if you do not know the vehicle subgroup, the CO<sub>2</sub> emission class finder at [www.myto.cz/en/kalkulace-co2](http://www.myto.cz/en/kalkulace-co2) will help you find it)
- Specific CO<sub>2</sub> emissions of the vehicle – they are specified in the CIF, or in the COC document



### 2 Documents

- Vehicle registration certificate
- Customer information file (CIF) - from 2022 manufacturers provide the COC document



### 1 Table

Enter the three details in the CO<sub>2</sub> emission class finder to determine the vehicle CO<sub>2</sub> emission class. If the finder confirms the eligibility for CO<sub>2</sub> emission class 2 or higher, you can apply to be assigned to a higher CO<sub>2</sub> emission class to secure lower fees.

You can submit your application at the Customer Zone, by e-mail, in person at Contact Points, or with the assistance of selected fuel card issuers. Documents proving all the relevant parameters of the vehicle need to be attached to your application.
