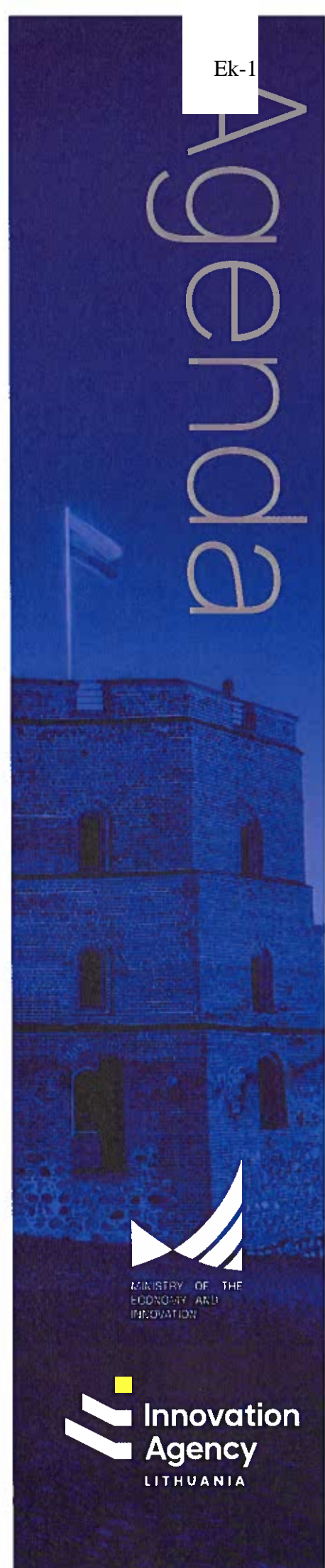

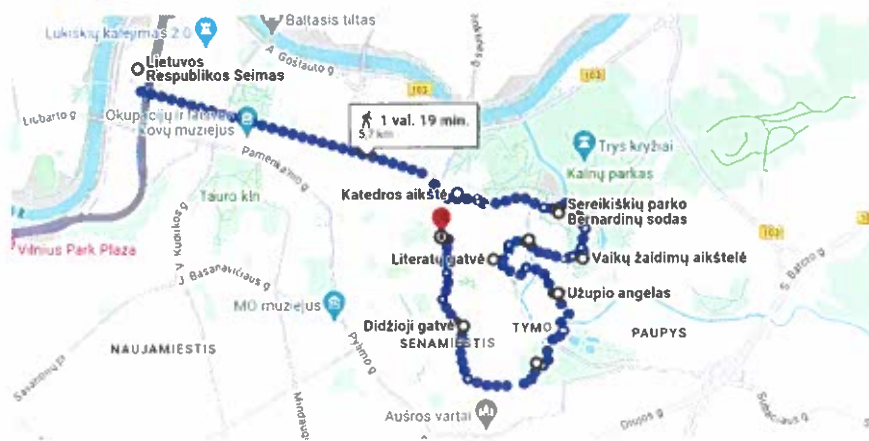

Lukiškės prison - It is an old prison built in the Tsarist times, converted into a cultural hub a few years ago, with great indoor and outdoor bars and generally unique atmosphere. There are also guided walks in EN during the day and night.

Gediminas Castle Hill - great panorama of Vilnius old town and cardio walking up

Užupis republic - the independent artists' republic with its own constitution.

MO Museum - Modern art museum with an exhibition for Vilnius' 700-year birthday
